


Reinke Appointed to Vice Chair of the Federal Home Loan Bank of Chicago

John Reinke, Chairman of the Board of Directors for The Stephenson National Bank and Trust (SNBT,) has been appointed to the Vice Chair of the Board of Directors for the Federal Home Loan Bank (FHLB) Chicago.
